Did you know?

The Clinical Research department, a department of Regional Health, participates in multiple research studies throughout the year. The department provides research coordination and study management services for physicians conducting clinical research studies.

What does this mean?

Regional Health Clinical Research (RHCR) provides support to principal investigators conducting research from study start to study finish, including:

- Assistance with the implementation and administration of clinical studies
- Oversight of the submission process to the Institutional Review Board, including: reporting requirements, submission forms, and informed consent
- Provision of financial services for new studies, including study cost analysis and budget formulation
- Oversight of research participant registration and research billing
- Assistance with study advertisement and patient recruitment

RHCR provides support to inpatient, outpatient, surgical services, rehab, and a wide variety of specialty services, including:
